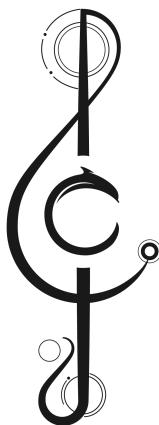
Free School Supplies for All TCS Students!
