



TCS Middle School Music Performance Attire 2025-26

Parents and Students,

Below are the guidelines for performances at The Conservatory School. Please read the guidelines carefully. Performance attire is either black pants & black shirt or a black dress. **Either option needs to be ordered from Cousin's Concert Attire.**

Black Dress Pants and Black Dress Shirt with Hunter Green Tie (Option 1)

- TCS black dress shirt and pants must be ordered from Cousin's Concert Attire. Click the link below [VINCENT \(Style #6701\) - Black Shirt With Dress Trousers Package](#)
- Black dress pants. ***The pants hem should come to the top of the foot.***
- Black dress shoes (no heels or sneakers). Black dress socks, please.

Concert Full Length Dress (Option 2)

- TCS Concert dress must be ordered from Cousin's Concert Attire. BLACK DRESS ONLY - Angelina (Style #115) (Click Link below) [ANGELINA \(Style #115\) - Scoop Neck, Short Sleeve Dress](#)
- The concert dress must be worn with ***a hem at the top of the foot.***
- Tights are not required, but if you wear socks, they must be the "no show" type that cannot be seen above your shoes.
- Black dress shoes (No heels or sneakers).

Undergarments should never be seen through any piece of clothing. No tinted lipstick is permitted. Hair should be pulled away from the face with a clip, headband, or hair tie. All hair accessories should be subtle.

Neutral color stockings or black, if needed, can be worn.

PERFORMANCE DRESS HEMMING INFORMATION

You must order the performance dress yourself. Please remember that the dresses may not be an exact fit for your child in all measurements.

The tie at the back allows you to adjust the size slightly to best fit your child. We advise parents to make any alterations as soon as possible.

Please have a hem sewn in the dress—duct tape, safety pins, and staples are unacceptable. The hem needs to touch the top of the foot.

Please hem the dress to let it out an inch or two. There is plenty of extra fabric for letting down in the future.
